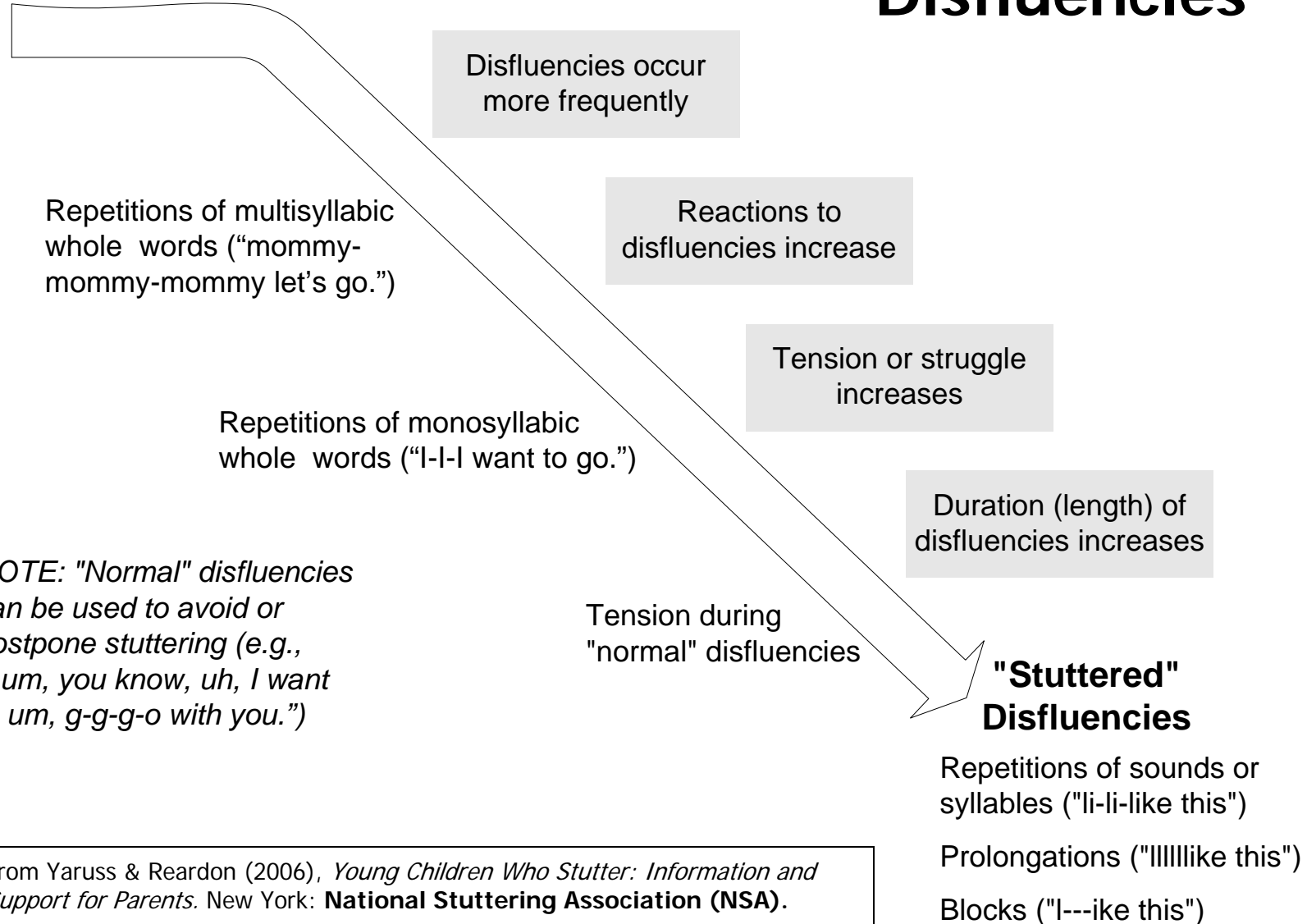


"Normal" Disfluencies

Hesitations (pause)
Interjections (um, uh, er)
Revisions ("I want-I need that")
Repetitions of phrases ("I want- I want that")

Understanding Different Types of Speech Disfluencies



NOTE: "Normal" disfluencies can be used to avoid or postpone stuttering (e.g., "I um, you know, uh, I want to um, g-g-g-o with you.")
